24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Counties are authorized to exchange properties, real or
27 personal, with other counties or with municipalities. Provided, any such
28 exchange shall be approved by ordinances of the quorum court and shall be
29 accomplished in accordance with procedures prescribed by the quorum court.
30

31 SECTION 2. Municipalities are authorized to exchange properties, real
32 or personal, with other municipalities or with counties, provided any such
33 exchange shall be approved by ordinance of the governing body of the
34 municipality and shall be accomplished in accordance with procedures
35 prescribed by the governing body.

1 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4
5 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10
11 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
