### For An Act To Be Entitled

### Subtitle

14 "TO ESTABLISH A FACILITY TO HOUSE  
15 JUVENILE OFFENDERS BETWEEN THE AGES OF  
16 EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE. "

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) The Division of Youth Services of the Department of  
22 Human Services shall establish a separate facility to house offenders between  
23 the ages of eighteen (18) and twenty-one (21) who have been committed to the  
24 Division of Youth Services.

25 (b) This facility shall be in operation by July 1, 2000 and shall be  
26 contigent upon funding.  
27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
36 Act are declared to be severable.
