20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Department of Arkansas State Police for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following  
24 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
25 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
26 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
28 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
32 successor.

36 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
2 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, after  
3 seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review  
4 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to request  
5 transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds Transfer"  
6 to the various line items contained in the operations appropriation of the  
7 Department of Arkansas State Police; and to request fund transfers from the  
8 Court Awards Fund to the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same  
9 amount as the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this  
10 section. Further provided, the Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby  
11 authorized to request a fund transfer from the Court Awards Fund to the Motor  
12 Vehicle Acquisition Revolving Fund. Fund transfers to the Motor Vehicle  
13 Acquisition Revolving Fund shall be reported to the Arkansas Legislative  
14 Council, but do not require prior review.

16 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. OVERTIME. The Department of Arkansas State  
17 Police is hereby authorized to make overtime payments from such funds and  
18 appropriations provided for overtime payments to those officers or other  
19 employees that are currently assigned or may be assigned by the Director of  
20 the Department of Arkansas State Police to Special Law Enforcement Task  
21 Forces. All such overtime payments shall be processed through the State  
22 Accounting System and shall be in addition to the Regular Salaries and

31 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MOTOR  
33 VEHICLE REPLACEMENT. The Department of Arkansas State Police may, at its  
34 discretion, replace any of its motor vehicles that indicate an odometer  
35 reading of less than seventy-five thousand (75,000) miles.

SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. UNIFORM ALLOWANCE. Arkansas Code Annotated 12-8-209(b)(2) is hereby amended to read as follows: "(b)(2) Each telecommunications supervisor, telecommunications operator, ~~and driver's license examiner,~~ and driver's license/commercial driver's license coordinator may receive up to, but shall not exceed, one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per annum for uniform allowance."

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 18 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FIREARMS  
 20 INVESTIGATIVE UNIT/FIREARMS TRACING AND IDENTIFICATION. The Department of  
 21 Arkansas State Police and the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory shall enter into  
 22 an interagency agreement for the implementation and operation of each agencies  
 23 respective component and functions involving a joint program regarding  
 24 Firearms Investigation and Firearms Tracing and Identification. The Department  
 25 of Arkansas State police shall be responsible for the operations of the  
 26 Firearms Investigative component and the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory shall  
 27 be responsible for the operations of the Firearms Tracing and Identification  
 28 component of the program.

29  
 30 Of the total number of positions authorized in Section 15 and of the total  
 31 amount appropriated by Section 16 herein, the Department of Arkansas State  
 32 Police shall act only as the Disbursing Officer for the Arkansas State Crime  
 33 Laboratory for the appropriation and funds to support two (2) Regular Salary  
 34 positions consisting of the "Management Project Analyst I" and "Document  
 35 Examiner", and appropriation and funds totaling \$87,115 in fiscal year 1999-00  
 36 and \$55,718 in fiscal year 2000-01 that is provided for the salaries and

1 operational support of the Firearms Tracing and Investigation portion of the  
2 total. Further, the Arkansas State Crime Laboratory shall have full authority  
3 and discretion regarding the employment and termination of the Management  
4 Project Analyst I and the Document Examiner position's authorized in Section  
5 15, and full authority and discretion regarding the budgeting and expenditure  
6 of that portion of the total appropriation and funds provided in Section 16  
7 herein for the operations of the Firearms Tracing and Identification component  
8 of the program.

9  
10 SECTION 18. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
13 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
14 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
15 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
16 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
17 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
18 with in disbursement of said funds.

19  
20 SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
27 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28  
29 SECTION 20. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32  
33 SECTION 21. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
34 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
35 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
36 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the

1 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

2  
3 SECTION 22. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
4 this act are hereby repealed.

5  
6 SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
7 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
8 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
9 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of  
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the  
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
