20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
23 the Arkansas Public Defender Commission - Operations for the 1999-2001
24 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
25 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
26 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
27 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
28 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
29 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
30 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
31 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
32 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

SECTION 7. REGULAR SALARIES - OMBUDSMAN PROGRAM. There is hereby established for the Arkansas Public defender Commission - Ombudsman Program for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. 32 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 34 RESTRICTIONS. Of the total positions and appropriations authorized in Section
 35 4 and Section 5 of this act for TRIAL PUBLIC DEFENDER OFFICE, the following
 36 positions and appropriations shall be utilized only to the extent that the

fees generated through the provisions of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 are available to support it:

Unless specified otherwise in Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) and Arkansas Code 16-87-213 the monies collected by the courts under the authority of §5-4-303(g) and 16-87-213 shall be deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the State Central Services Fund Account there to be used solely to defray the costs of the positions and appropriations as restricted by and as set out in this section.

In the event that the law requires that the fees levied under §5-4-303(g) be deposited into the State Administration of Justice Fund, the State Treasurer shall transfer the amount of the fees collected each month under the authority of Arkansas Code §5-4-303(g) from the State Administration of Justice Fund to the State Central Services Fund Account there to be used to defray the costs of the positions and appropriations as restricted by and as set out in this section.

1 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
2 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
3 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
4 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
5 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
6 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
7 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
8 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
9 with in disbursement of said funds.

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11 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
12 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
13 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
14 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
15 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
17 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
18 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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20 SECTION 12. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
21 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
22 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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24 SECTION 13. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
25 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
26 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
27 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
28 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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30 SECTION 14. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
31 this act are hereby repealed.

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33 SECTION 15. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
34 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
35 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
36 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of

1 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
3 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
4 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
5 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
6 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
7 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
