9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE § 27-35-210 TO
10 AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION TO
11 ISSUE SPECIAL PERMITS FOR THE MOVEMENT OF OVERWEIGHT
12 VEHICLES TRANSPORTING CROSS-TIES FROM THEIR FIRST
13 POINT OF PROCESSING TO THE POINT AT WHICH THEY SHALL
14 UNDERGO CREOSOTE PROCESSING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-35-210 is amended to add an additional
25 subsection to read as follows:

26 "(k) The State Highway Commission is authorized to issue special
27 permits at a charge of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for a one (1) year permit
28 for the movement of cross-ties from their first point of processing to the
29 point at which they shall undergo creosote processing by five-axle vehicles
30 registered and licensed pursuant to Arkansas Code 27-14-601(a)(3)(G)(ii) where
31 the loaded weight on any tandem axle on such vehicles is greater than the
32 allowable tandem axle limit of thirty-four thousand (34,000) pounds, provided
33 the one-way mileage for such transportation trip is no greater than one
34 hundred (100) miles, no tandem axle weight exceeds thirty-six thousand five
35 hundred (36,500) pounds, and no portion of such trip is on any part of the
36 federal interstate highways. The State Highway Commission shall issue no more

1 than five (5) special permits to the same person during the same calendar
2 year. "

4 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of general and permanent nature
5 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
6 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

7

8 SECTION 3. If any provisions of this act or the application thereof to
9 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect
10 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
11 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
12 act are declared to be severable.

13

14 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
15 hereby repealed.
