## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 15-75-304 PERTAINING TO  
10 CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY TO ENGAGE IN THE LIQUEFIED  
11 PETROLEUM GAS BUSINESS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

## Subtitle

13 "TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 15-75-304  
14 PERTAINING TO CERTIFICATES OF COMPETENCY  
15 TO ENGAGE IN THE LIQUEFIED PETROLEUM GAS  
16 BUSINESS. "

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 15-75-304 is amended by adding a new  
23 subsection to read as follows:

24 "(e) The Board may accept as its own, a reciprocal state's  
25 transportation and delivery examination for transport drivers only, which  
26 contains substantially equivalent requirements as those required by the  
27 Liquefied Petroleum Gas Board. Substantial uniformity shall be demonstrated  
28 by a letter from the issuing authority of the state or a copy of a current and  
29 valid card issued by the reciprocal state. All applicable fees shall be paid  
30 to the Board prior to issuance of the certification card.  
31

32 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
33 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
34 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
35

36 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to

1 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
2 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
3 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
4 act are declared to be severable.

5  
6 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
7 hereby repealed.
