20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STAFF SERVICES. There is hereby established
23 for the Arkansas Senate - Staff Services for the 1999-2001 biennium, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees and the maximum annual salaries
25 for each position. The maximum annual salary for the positions set out in
26 dollars shall not exceed the maximum set forth herein. All positions set
27 forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions of the Uniform
28 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, but not be exempt from
29 the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its
30 successor.

 25 established for the Arkansas Senate - Committee Staffing for the 1999-2001
 26 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees and the maximum
 27 annual salaries for each position. The maximum annual salary for the
 28 positions set out in dollars shall not exceed the maximum set forth herein.
 29 All positions set forth herein shall be exempt from other provisions of the
 30 Uni form Classi fication and Compensation Act, or its successor, but not be
 31 exempt from the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restri tions
 32 Act, or its successor.

There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Senate - Committee Staffing for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the following:

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - ORIENTATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, to be used for payment of per diem and mileage of members of the Arkansas Senate who attend the Biennial Senate Orientation program held prior to the convening of the 2001 Regular Session of the General Assembly, the sum of\$10,000.

SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION AND CARRYOVER. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund or the State Central Services Fund, whichever is appropriate, for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the balance of the appropriations enacted by the Eighty-second General Assembly to defray the expenses of the Arkansas Senate of the Eighty-second General Assembly, Item (23) of Section 1 of Act 3 of 1997 and Sections 2, 4, 6 and 9 of Act 375 of

1 1997, in a sum in the aggregate not to exceed\$1,900,000.

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3 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
4 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
5 Any balance remaining on June 30, 2000 in the appropriation provided by
6 Section 2 of this act for Maintenance and General Operations shall be carried
7 forward and made available for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2001 for the
8 same purposes.

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10 SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - COMPUTERIZATION. There is hereby appropriated,
11 to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund,
12 for expenses necessary in continuing the computerization of the legislative
13 process in the Arkansas Senate, the sum of\$500,000.

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15 SECTION 9. APPROPRIATION - RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS. There is hereby
16 appropriated, to the Arkansas Senate, to be payable from the State Central
17 Services Fund, for renovations, remodeling, construction, equipping for areas
18 assigned to the Senate and associated costs, the sum of\$500,000.

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20 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENATE
22 COMMITTEES. The Senate Efficiency Committee may employ, using positions
23 authorized in Section 3, Legislative Analysts and Secretaries for Senate
24 committees.

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26 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFERS.
28 If the Senate Efficiency Committee and the Senate Fiscal Officer, subject to
29 the approval of the Arkansas Senate, should determine that any item or portion
30 thereof appropriated herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such
31 purpose, the Senate Fiscal Officer may certify such fact to the State Auditor
32 and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made from one item to
33 another.

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35 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENATE

1 EMPLOYEES. The Senate Efficiency Committee may, at its discretion and subject
2 to the approval of the Arkansas Senate, employ, transfer or discharge Arkansas
3 Senate employees if it is determined by the committee to be in the best
4 interest of the Arkansas Senate. The actual salaries to be paid to employees
5 of the Arkansas Senate shall be determined by the Senate Efficiency Committee
6 within the funds, appropriations and maximum annual salaries as may be
7 available.

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9 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11 in this Act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this Act
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
16 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 14. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
19 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
20 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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22 SECTION 15. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this Act or the application
23 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
24 not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given
25 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
26 provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

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28 SECTION 16. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
29 this Act are hereby repealed.

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31 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
32 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
33 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
34 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
4 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
