20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 2-20-404(a)(1)(C), pertaining to the
23 membership of the Arkansas Soybean Promotion Board, is amended to read as
24 follows:

25 "(C) All of the nine (9) producer members of the board shall be
26 practical producers of soybeans in the State of Arkansas and shall be ~~members~~
27 ~~of the boards of directors of~~ nominated by their respective organizations. "

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 2-20-604(b)(2), pertaining to the membership
30 of the Arkansas Wheat Promotion Board, is amended to read as follows:

31 "(2) All of the nine (9) members of the board shall be practical
32 producers of wheat in the State of Arkansas and shall be ~~members of the boards~~
33 ~~of directors of~~ nominated by their respective organizations. "

35 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
36 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code

1 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.
