23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.

26 There is hereby established for the Department of Education - General
27 Education Division - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the
28 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
29 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
30 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
31 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
32 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
33 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
34 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
35 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
36 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

31 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.

32 There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - General
33 Education Division - Arkansas School for Mathematics and Sciences for the
34 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
35 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein
36 for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at

1 rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uni form Cl assi fi cation and
 2 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate
 3 cl assi fi cation.

5 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS SCHOOL FOR MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCES.

6 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education - General
 7 Education Division, to be payable from the Department of Education Public
 8 School Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 9 Department of Education - General Education Division - Arkansas School for
 10 Mathematics and Sciences for the biennial period ending June 30, 2001, the
 11 fol low ing:

8 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 9 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SUMMER SCHOOL
 10 EMPLOYEES. Employees who, in addition to working during the regular school
 11 term also work during the summer months, shall be authorized as additional
 12 compensation an amount not to exceed 1/12 of their annual salary for each
 13 month or part thereof worked. Such additional compensation shall not be
 14 construed as exceeding the maximum salary authorized for said employees.
 15 Payment of additional compensation shall be limited to employees in the
 16 following classifications:

26 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 27 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 28 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 29 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 30 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 31 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 32 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 34 with in disbursement of said funds.

35

36 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
7 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 8. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
10 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
11 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

12
13 SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
14 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
15 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
16 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
17 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

18
19 SECTION 10. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
20 this act are hereby repealed.

21
22 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
23 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
24 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
25 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
27 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
28 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
29 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
31 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
