22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY.
25 There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas - Various Divisions
26 and the Archeological Survey for the 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum
27 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
28 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
29 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
30 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
31 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
32 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
33 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
34 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
35 successor.

35 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 36 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO

1 EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity or redemptions of
2 investments as authorized in Section ~~6~~ 7 of this Act for the University of
3 Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Program shall be deemed "Refunds to
4 Expenditures" for all monies invested.

5

6 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
7 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS AND
8 CONTRACTS. The Arkansas Archeological Survey is authorized to enter into
9 contracts with and to receive and expend gifts, grants, or other funds from
10 federal, private, or other sources to be used in furtherance of the program of
11 the Survey within the limitations of the maximum annual salary rates as set
12 forth in this Act.

13

14 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USE AND
16 DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under Section ~~3~~ 4 and allocated in
17 Item (5) of Section 4 5 of this Act are to be used for the personal services
18 and maintenance and general operation of the Arkansas Archeological Survey and
19 for no other purpose. The Vice-President for Finance and Administration of
20 the University of Arkansas is hereby made the disbursing officer for the
21 appropriation made by this Act.

22

23 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
25 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing and
26 other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of the athletic directors,
27 associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches, assistant coaches,
28 offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head trainers in the men's
29 and women's Athletic Departments at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville,
30 the Board of Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such
31 amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable
32 allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic
33 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches,
34 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head
35 trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of
36 Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such allowances, the

1 Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary income of the
2 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from athletic event
3 receipts, or from contributions from sources other than state funds, an amount
4 not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such purposes during
5 each year of the ~~1997-99~~ 1999-2001 biennium for the athletic directors,
6 associate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an amount not to exceed
7 one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant athletic directors, ~~and~~
8 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head
9 trainers. Any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of
10 such athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head
11 coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the special allowance funds
12 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall
13 report annually to the Arkansas Legislative Joint Auditing Committee ~~the exact~~
14 ~~disposition of the~~ those special allowance funds authorized herein.

15 In recognition of the extra work involved in the participation of
16 intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season competition, and to promote
17 exceptional achievement in the total sports program, the Chancellor of the
18 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in accordance with policies issued by
19 the Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas, may approve additional
20 compensation of up to one month's salary for the Athletic Department and Band
21 personnel when any athletic team participates in post-season competition or
22 achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be in addition to the regular
23 salaries authorized by law, provided that the additional compensation shall be
24 paid from contributions from sources other than public funds.

25

26 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITIONS
28 AND FUNDS RESTRICTED. None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated
29 herein shall be used for the support of the Science Information Liaison Office
30 (SIL0) program, the Community Assistance Program, or their successor programs.

31 All assets and funds allocated to the SIL0 program shall be transferred to
32 the Bureau of Legislative Research, to be used for research and constituency
33 services for the 135 members of the Arkansas General Assembly.

34

35 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL

1 PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas is
2 hereby authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at the
3 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, from revenues generated by contracts
4 with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such amounts as
5 may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the coaches of
6 consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the University
7 and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall not be
8 considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum
9 salaries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. Nothing in
10 this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted
11 elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to
12 coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville.

13
14 SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
15 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
17 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
18 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
19 and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
20 their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
21 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
22 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
23 disbursement of said funds.

24
25 SECTION 15. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
26 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
27 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
28 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
29 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
30 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
31 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
32 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

33
34 SECTION 16. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
35 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
36 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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SECTION 17. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 18. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
