### Subtitle

13 "AN ACT CONCERNING NOTICE OF A CHANGE IN  
14 POLLING SITES. "

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. *Arkansas Code 7-5-101 (d) is amended to read as follows:*

21 *"(d) Notice of any changes made in polling sites shall also be given to*  
22 *the electors by posting information about any such changes prominently at all*  
23 *previous polling sites which were used in the last election. Except for*  
24 *school elections and special elections, the notice shall also be mailed by the*  
25 *county clerk to each affected registered voter at least fifteen (15) days*  
26 *before the election."*  
27

28 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
29 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
30 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
31

32 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
33 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
34 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
35 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
36 act are declared to be severable.
