17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 24-11-203(b)(1) is hereby amended to read as  
20 follows:

21 "(b)(1) The board shall be composed of ~~seven (7)~~ nine (9) persons as  
22 follows:

23 (A) Two (2) fire fighters, one of whom shall be appointed by the  
24 Governor from a list submitted by the Arkansas Council of Professional Fire  
25 Fighters and the other from a list submitted by the Arkansas State Fire  
26 Fighters Association;

27 (B) Two (2) police officers to be appointed by the Governor, one from a  
28 list submitted by the Arkansas Municipal Police Association and the other from  
29 a list submitted by the Fraternal Order of Police;

30 (C) ~~Two (2)~~ Three (3) persons to be appointed by the Governor from a  
31 list submitted by the Arkansas Municipal League; ~~and~~

32 (D) One (1) person who is not a member, retirant, or beneficiary of the  
33 system and who is not a current or former member of the governing body of any  
34 political subdivision, to be appointed by the Governor from a list of persons  
35 submitted to him by the Joint Committee on Public Retirement-; and

36 (E) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration."

SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
