20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 13-10-101 is amended to read as follows:
23 "13-10-101. Creation - Functions and duties.

24 There is hereby created the Arkansas Medal of Honor Commission to be
25 composed of those persons appointed by Acting Governor Stanley Russ on
26 November 20, 1996, to the Arkansas Medal of Honor Commission created by
27 Governor's Proclamation of that date and such other members as shall be
28 appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. The
29 commission shall establish a permanent monument or other appropriate memorial
30 to honor Arkansans who have been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. The
31 commission is charged with the duty of soliciting funds necessary to
32 accomplish its purposes. Any vacancies occurring on the commission shall be
33 filled by appointment by the Governor with the advice and consent of the
34 Senate."

36 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature

1 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
2 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

3
4 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
5 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
6 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 act are declared to be severable.

9
10 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
11 hereby repealed.
