22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-8-210 is amended to read as follows:

25 "3-8-210. Authority to continue to issue sale permits.

26 The Alcoholic Beverage Control Division shall have the authority to
27 continue to issue permits for the sale of beer, vinous, spirituous, and malt
28 liquor in any political subdivision of the State of Arkansas of the same kind
29 and type issued prior to July 4, ~~1983~~ 1996, provided that the electorate of
30 such political subdivision has not since July 4, ~~1983~~ 1996, held an election
31 under the provisions of Initiated Act No. 1 of 1942, §§ 3-8-201 - 3-8-203 and
32 3-8-205 - 3-8-209."

34 SECTION 2. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent nature
35 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
36 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are declared to be severable.

SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are hereby repealed.
