## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 "AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE ARKANSAS STATE  
10 BOARD OF PHARMACY IN REGARD TO THE INSPECTION OF  
11 HOSPITAL PHARMACIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. "

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 20-92-205(c) is amended to read as follows:

23 " (c) The board's inspectors shall have the power and authority to  
24 inspect any store or business establishment, including any hospital pharmacy  
25 or any other facility holding a license or permit issued by the board, where  
26 drugs, medicines, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, or poisons regulated by the  
27 board are manufactured, sold, or dispensed. "  
28

29 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature  
30 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code  
31 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.  
32

33 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to  
34 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
35 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without  
36 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

1 act are declared to be severable.

3 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are  
4 hereby repealed.
