34 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

 15 EXEMPTION. Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically exempt  
 16 from limitation of hours, either by act or regulation. Provided, however,  
 17 when a temporary or part-time employee is employed by the Department of  
 18 Finance and Administration - Revenue Services for a period of time exceeding  
 19 seven (7) months, a report of such shall be filed with the Arkansas  
 20 Legislative Council.

21

22 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL  
 24 RATES OF PAY. *Due to the highly competitive job market conditions for tax  
 25 auditing professionals and the necessity of recruiting and retaining qualified  
 26 personnel, the Revenue Division Office of Field Audit is authorized special  
 27 rates of pay for current and new employees in the classification listed under  
 28 subsection (a) below.*

29

30 (a) *Special rates may be authorized up to the maximum authorized for the  
 31 grade assigned the classification of a position for the following specific  
 32 classifications only:*

5 (b) Applications for special rates of pay indicated in subsection (a)  
6 shall be reviewed by and approved by the Office of Personnel Management.

7 (c) This provision shall be in full force and effect for the biennium  
8 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2001.

9

10 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
13 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
14 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
15 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
16 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
17 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
18 with in disbursement of said funds.

19

20 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
27 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

28

29 SECTION 26. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent  
30 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas  
31 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

32

33 SECTION 27. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application  
34 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall  
35 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given  
36 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the

1 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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3 SECTION 28. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with  
4 this act are hereby repealed.

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6 SECTION 29. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the  
7 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas  
8 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that  
9 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of  
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
11 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
12 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the  
13 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
14 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
15 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
16 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 1999.
