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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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28 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - COLLEGE OF INFORMATION SCIENCES AND SYSTEMS
29 ENGINEERING. There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas at
30 Little Rock - College of Information Sciences and Systems Engineering for the
31 1999-2001 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose
32 salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
33 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
34 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
35 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
36 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All

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1 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
 2 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
 3 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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10 In the event that there are not sufficient funds to make the full
 11 distributions as set out in this section, each institution's share of the
 12 amount available to be distributed shall be the institution's proportionate
 13 part of the total of all distributions authorized herein.

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15 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL OR TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
 17 TRANSFER. FUNDING TRANSFER. On July 1, 1999, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 18 State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of
 19 \$2,000,000 from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the University
 20 of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund and on July 1, 2000 the sum of \$5,000,000 from
 21 the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the University of Arkansas at
 22 Little Rock Fund or so much thereof as is required to provide funds for the
 23 appropriation provided herein for the operations of the College of Information
 24 Sciences and Systems Engineering.

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26 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 27 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SET ASIDE.
 28 Effective immediately, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall set aside
 29 the sum of twenty-two million dollars (\$22,000,000) from the General Revenue
 30 Allotment Reserve Fund, or so much thereof as is required to fund the
 31 appropriations in this Act. The funds set aside shall be restricted and used
 32 solely for the purposes as appropriated in this act.

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34 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 35 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 36 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions

1 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
2 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
3 Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their
4 successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and
5 regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as
6 authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said
7 funds.

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9 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
16 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 10. CODE. All provisions of this Act of a general and permanent
19 nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas
20 Code Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

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22 SECTION 11. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this act or the application
23 thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall
24 not affect other provisions or applications of the act which can be given
25 effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
26 provisions of this act are declared to be severable.

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28 SECTION 12. GENERAL REPEALER. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with
29 this act are hereby repealed.

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31 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
32 Eighty-second General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
33 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
34 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 1999 is essential to the operation of
35 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
36 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective

1 date of this Act beyond July 1, 1999 could work irreparable harm upon the
2 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
3 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and section 7 of this Act
4 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
5 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
6 passage and approval and the remaining sections in this act shall be in full
7 force and effect on July 1, 1999.
