19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 3-5-302(6)(B) is amended to read as follows:

22 "(B) The requirement as to residence in the United States
23 or citizenship of the United States shall not apply to officers, directors,
24 and stockholders of the corporation, but the requirement shall apply to any
25 officer, director, or stockholder who is also the manager of the licensed
26 premises, in any capacity, in the conduct or operation of the licensed
27 premises. "

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 3-9-305(6)(B) is amended to read as follows:

30 "(B) The requirement as to residence in the United States
31 or citizenship of the United States shall not apply to officers, directors,
32 and stockholders of the corporation, but the requirement shall apply to any
33 officer, director, or stockholder who is also the manager of the licensed
34 premises, in any capacity, in the conduct or operation of the licensed
35 premises; "

1 SECTION 3. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

5 SECTION 4. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

11 SECTION 5. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
