26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
27

28 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-9-602 is amended to add an additional
29 subsection at the end thereof to read as follows:

30 "(e) The Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, its
31 members and its employees, who disclose information pursuant to this section
32 are immune from civil liability for such disclosure or its consequences. The
33 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, its members and its
34 employees shall not be civilly liable for disclosure of information under this
35 subchapter or performing any other duties under this subchapter."

1 SECTION 2. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature
2 are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code
3 Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.

4
5 SECTION 3. If any provision of this act or the application thereof to
6 any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect
7 other provisions or applications of the act which can be given effect without
8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
9 act are declared to be severable.

10
11 SECTION 4. All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this act are
12 hereby repealed.
