23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-36-103(b), concerning theft of property, is
26 amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

27 (5)(A) Theft of property is a *Class D* felony if the value of the
28 property is five hundred dollars (\$500) or less, and the property was
29 unlawfully obtained during a criminal episode.

30 (B) For purposes of this subdivision (b)(5), "criminal
31 episode" means a series of thefts committed by the same person on three (3)
32 or more occasions within three (3) days.
