23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - VARIOUS DIVISIONS AND ARCHEOLOGICAL SURVEY.

26 There is hereby established for the University of Arkansas - Various Divisions
27 and the Archeological Survey for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum
28 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
29 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
30 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
31 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
32 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
33 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
34 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
35 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
36 successor.

34 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 35 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO
 36 EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the maturity or redemptions of

1 investments as authorized in Section 7 6 of this Act for the University of
2 Arkansas Soils Testing and Research Program shall be deemed "Refunds to

21 DISBURSING OFFICER. The funds appropriated under Section 4 3 and allocated in

31 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
33 ALLOWANCES. For the purpose of providing necessary allowances for housing and
34 other unusual expenses incurred by or on behalf of the athletic directors,
35 associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches, assistant coaches,
36 offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head trainers in the men's

1 and women's Athletic Departments at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville,
2 the Board of Trustees may make special allowances available therefor in such
3 amounts as the Board of Trustees may determine as justified, an equitable
4 allowance in view of the unusual and exacting duties of said athletic
5 directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head coaches,
6 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head
7 trainers in the men's and women's Athletic Departments at the University of
8 Arkansas, Fayetteville, and for the purpose of providing such allowances, the
9 Board of Trustees is authorized to expend from the auxiliary income of the
10 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, which is derived from athletic event
11 receipts, or from contributions from sources other than state funds, an amount
12 not to exceed ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for such purposes during
13 each year of the ~~1999-2001~~ 2001-2003 biennium for the athletic directors,
14 associate athletic directors, and head coaches, and an amount not to exceed
15 one thousand dollars (\$1,000) each for the assistant athletic directors,
16 assistant coaches, offensive coordinators, defensive coordinators, and head
17 trainers. Any such allowances shall be in addition to the regular salary of
18 such athletic directors, associate and assistant athletic directors, head
19 coaches and assistant coaches. Further, if the special allowance funds
20 authorized herein are utilized the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville shall
21 report annually to the Arkansas Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact
22 disposition of those special allowance funds. In recognition of the extra work
23 involved in the participation of intercollegiate athletic teams in post-season
24 competition, and to promote exceptional achievement in the total sports
25 program, the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, in
26 accordance with policies issued by the Board of Trustees of the University of
27 Arkansas, may approve additional compensation of up to one month's salary for
28 the Athletic Department and Band personnel when any athletic team participates
29 in post-season competition or achieves exceptional recognition, which shall be
30 in addition to the regular salaries authorized by law, provided that the
31 additional compensation shall be paid from contributions from sources other
32 than public funds.

33

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
35 through June 30, 2003.

36

1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSITIONS
3 AND FUNDS RESTRICTED. None of the positions authorized or funds appropriated
4 herein shall be used for the support of the Science Information Liaison Office
5 (SILO) program, the Community Assistance Program, or their successor programs.
6 All assets and funds allocated to the SILO program shall be transferred to
7 the Bureau of Legislative Research, to be used for research and constituency
8 services for the 135 members of the Arkansas General Assembly.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
11 through June 30, 2003.

13 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL
15 PAYMENTS AUTHORIZED. The Board of Trustees of the University of Arkansas is
16 hereby authorized to make additional payments to head coaches at the
17 University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, from revenues generated by contracts
18 with vendors of athletic apparel, shoes and other products in such amounts as
19 may be established by the Board of Trustees for performance by the coaches of
20 consulting and other obligations pursuant to contracts between the University
21 and such vendors. Such additional payments to head coaches shall not be
22 considered salary and shall not be deemed or construed to exceed the maximum
23 salaries established for such coaches by the General Assembly. Nothing in
24 this section shall be construed to reduce or eliminate the authority granted
25 elsewhere in Arkansas statutes for the payment of allowances or bonuses to
26 coaches at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville.

27
28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
29 through June 30, 2003.

30
31 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARY
33 INCREASE RESTRICTIONS. Annual salary increases for each fiscal year of the
34 2001-03 biennium for all of those employees paid from each of those titles set
35 out in the headings identified as "TWELVE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL ADMIN
36 POSITIONS-FAYETTEVILLE"; "TWELVE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL ACADEMIC

1 POSITIONS”, with the exception of Senior Graduate Assistant and Graduate
2 Assistant titles; “NINE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL ACADEMIC POSITIONS”,
3 with the exception of Instructor and Lecturer titles; “AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT
4 STATION TWELVE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE POSITIONS”;
5 “AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION TWELVE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND GENERAL ACADEMIC
6 POSITIONS”; and “COOPERATIVE EXTENSION SERVICE TWELVE MONTH EDUCATIONAL AND
7 GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE POSITIONS” in Section 1 of this Act shall not, in the
8 aggregate, exceed 2.6%.

9
10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
11 through June 30, 2003.

12
13 SECTION 14. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
14 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
15 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
16 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
17 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
18 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
19 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.

20 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
21 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
22 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
23 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
24 include the following:

- 25 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
26 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 27 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
28 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 29 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
30 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 31 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
32 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
33 depletion of the fund balance.

34 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
35 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
36 prior review by the Legislative Council.

1
2 SECTION 15. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
3 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
5 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
6 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
7 and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
8 their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
9 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
10 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
11 disbursement of said funds.

12
13 SECTION 16. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
20 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

21
22 SECTION 17. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
24 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
26 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
27 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
28 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
29 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
30 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
31 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
32 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
