SECTION 8. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all

- 1 <u>appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall</u>
- 2 <u>monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly</u>
- 3 <u>basis</u>. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
- 4 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
- 5 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
- 6 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
- 7 <u>head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the</u>
- 8 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall

13	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
14	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
15	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
16	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
17	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
