10 FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR
11 VARIOUS MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
12 PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - VARIOUS MUNICIPAL AND COMMUNITY PROJECTS.

26 There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration
27 - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
28 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:
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30 (A) For the City of Forrest City, Arkansas for renovation and repair of the
31 J.H. King Community Center, the sum of\$100,000.

32 (B) For the City of Earle, Arkansas for renovation and acquisition for a
33 new city hall, the sum of\$50,000.

34 (C) For the City of Jennette for municipal infrastructure projects
35 including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction
36 and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the

1 sum of \$50,000.

2 (D) For the City of Hughes for costs associated with the land acquisition,
3 building construction, renovation and improvement of the Hughes Community
4 Development Corporation, the sum \$50,000.

5 (E) For the City of Madison for municipal infrastructure projects including
6 but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction and
7 improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the sum
8 of \$50,000.

9 (F) For the City of Marvell for municipal infrastructure projects
10 including, but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street
11 construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal
12 buildings, the sum of \$50,000.

13 (G) For the City of Crawfordsville for municipal infrastructure projects
14 including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction
15 and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the
16 sum of \$50,000.

17 (H) For the City of Edmondson for municipal infrastructure projects
18 including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction
19 and improvement, and construction and renovation of municipal buildings, the
20 sum of \$50,000.

21 (I) For the City of Edmondson, to be used exclusively for infrastructure
22 projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street
23 construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of public
24 buildings in the Anthonyville community, the sum of \$50,000.

25 (J) For the City of Rondo, to be used for municipal infrastructure projects
26 including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street construction
27 and improvement, and construction and renovation of public buildings, the sum
28 of \$25,000.

29 (K) For the City of LaGrange, to be used for municipal infrastructure
30 projects including but not limited to sewer and water improvements, street
31 construction and improvement, and construction and renovation of public
32 buildings, the sum of \$25,000.

33 (L) For the City of Lakeview, Arkansas, to be used for municipal
34 infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water
35 improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and
36 renovation of public buildings, the sum of \$50,000.

1 (M) For the City of Aubrey, Arkansas, to be used for municipal
2 infrastructure projects including but not limited to sewer and water
3 improvements, street construction and improvement, and construction and
4 renovation of public buildings, the sum of\$25,000.

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6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. There is
7 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
8 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
9 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

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11 (A) For operations, maintenance and equipment for the Steudlein Learning
12 Center in Crittenden County, the sum of\$23,000.

13 (B) For a grant to be divided equally between the cities of Gilmore and
14 Turrell, a sum not to exceed\$25,000.

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16 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CEMETERY RESTORATION. There is hereby
17 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
18 Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund
19 or fund accounts, the following:

20 (A) For the Department of Arkansas Heritage for grants for the restoration
21 of cemeteries in Lee, Phillips, and St. Francis Counties, the sum of
22\$100,000.
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24 SECTION 4. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
25 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
26 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
27 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
28 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
29 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
30 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
31 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
32 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
33 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
34 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
35 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

36 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing

1 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
2 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
3 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
4 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
5 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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7 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
8 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
9 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
10 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
11 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
12 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
13 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
14 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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16 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
18 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
19 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
20 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
21 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
22 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
23 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
24 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
25 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
26 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
