24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-81-113(a), concerning warrantless arrests
27 for domestic abuse, are amended to read as follows:

28 (a)(1) When a law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe a
29 person has committed acts which constitute a crime under the laws of this
30 state and which constitute domestic abuse as defined herein against a family
31 or household member, the officer may arrest the person without a warrant if
32 the law enforcement officer has probable cause to believe the person, within
33 the preceding four (4) hours, twelve (12) hours for cases involving physical
34 injury, as defined in § 5-1-102, has committed such acts even if the incident
35 did not take place in the presence of the law enforcement officer.

36 (2) The arrest of the person shall be considered the preferred

1 action by the law enforcement officer when evidence indicates that domestic
2 abuse has occurred in addition to a violation of the Arkansas Criminal Code, §
3 5-1-101 et seq.

4 (3) Any law enforcement officer acting in good faith and
5 exercising due care in making an arrest for domestic abuse shall have immunity
6 from civil liability.
