18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-52-107(a)(2), concerning the signal legend
21 for traffic-control signals, is amended to read as follows:

22 (2) Steady yellow alone means:

23 (A) Vehicular traffic facing the signal is warned that the
24 red or "STOP" signal will be exhibited immediately thereafter, and vehicular
25 traffic shall not enter ~~or be crossing~~ the intersection when the red or
26 "STOP" signal is exhibited;

27 (B) Pedestrians facing the signal are advised that there
28 is insufficient time to cross the roadway, and any pedestrian then starting
29 to cross shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles;
