9 AN ACT TO CLARIFY AND RESTATE EXISTING LAW
10 REGARDING MUNICIPAL COURTS AND TO IMPLEMENT
11 CHANGES IN MUNICIPAL/DISTRICT COURTS PURSUANT TO
12 AMENDMENT 80 TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION; TO
13 PROVIDE FOR A METHOD OF FILLING VACANCIES; AND
14 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 TO CLARIFY THE LAW REGARDING MUNICIPAL

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 SECTION 1. (a) All municipal courts now in existence shall be known
27 as district courts and all judges of the former courts will be known as
28 district judges.

29 (b) District courts shall have the jurisdiction vested in the
30 presently established municipal courts.

31 (c) All fines, penalties and costs received by the district courts
32 shall continue to be collected and distributed in the manner provided by
33 current laws affecting municipal courts unless and until the General Assembly
34 establishes a new method of distribution.

35 (d) All salaries, retirement benefits, programs, and monies of judges,
36 clerks, and court employees of municipal courts will continue to be vested

1 and paid to the judges, clerks, and court employees of district courts
2 pending further acts of the General Assembly.

3
4 SECTION 2. A vacancy in a district court judgeship shall be filled in
5 the same manner and subject to the same restrictions as for vacancies under
6 Amendment 29 of the Arkansas Constitution.

7
8 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9 General Assembly that with the approval by the voters of Arkansas of
10 Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, the effectiveness of this act on
11 July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the state court system, and
12 that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the
13 effective date of this act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm
14 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
15 progress. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
16 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
17 safety shall become effective from and after July 1, 2001.
