21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-65-105 is amended to read as follows:

24 5-65-105. Operation of motor vehicle during period of license suspension
25 or revocation.

26 Any person whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle has been suspended
27 or revoked under the provisions of this act, who shall, during the period of
28 such suspension or revocation, operate a motor vehicle in this state, shall be
29 imprisoned for ten (10) days and may be assessed a fine of not more than one
30 thousand dollars (\$1000).
