18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning January 1, 2003, the offices of sheriff and
21 tax collector in Dallas County, Arkansas shall be separate offices.

22 (b) At the 2002 general election, the qualified electors of Dallas
23 County shall elect a sheriff and a tax collector and each officer so elected
24 shall take office on January 1, 2003.
25

26 SECTION 2. (a) The sheriff and the collector of Dallas County shall
27 each receive compensation as shall be determined by the quorum court of
28 Dallas County within the minimum and maximum compensation range prescribed by
29 the General Assembly, and shall hire other deputies as authorized and shall
30 have other allowances as shall be prescribed by the quorum court.

31 (b) The sheriff and tax collector in Dallas County shall each give
32 bond for the faithful performance of the duties of the office as is now or is
33 hereafter provided by law.
