19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. (a) There is created the Task Force on the Disparity in
22 Sentencing for Persons Convicted of Non-violent Crimes.

23 (b) The task force shall consist of fifteen (15) persons to be
24 appointed as follows:

25 (1) Five (5) members by the Governor;

26 (2) Five (5) members by the chair of the House Judiciary
27 Committee; and

28 (3) Five (5) members by the chair of the Senate Judiciary
29 Committee.
30

31 SECTION 2. The task force shall present its final report to the
32 General Assembly no later than November 1, 2002. This report shall include:

33 (1) The activities of the task force;

34 (2) The findings of the task force;

35 (3) Any recommendations for policies, or proposed legislation of
36 the task force; and
