21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 51, Subchapter 6, is amended*
24 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

25 *6-51-622. Noncommercial driver training instruction.*

26 *(a) Any person teaching or instructing persons under the age of*
27 *eighteen (18) to drive a noncommercial motor vehicle shall offer the minimum*
28 *amount of driver training to those student-drivers as prescribed by this*
29 *section.*

30 *(b) The minimum requirements for classroom driver training*
31 *instruction for noncommercial motor vehicles shall consist of:*

32 *(1) Thirty (30) hours or more of classroom instruction on*
33 *driving techniques and rules of the road in Arkansas, including six (6) hours*
34 *of classroom instruction on traffic law changes that have occurred within the*
35 *last ten (10) years; and*

36 *(2) Ten (10) hours of behind-the-wheel driving experience.*
