15 AN ACT FOR THE HEALTH SERVICES AGENCY
16 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2001-2003 BIENNIAL.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby
23 established for the Health Services Agency for the 2001-2003 biennium, the
24 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed
25 by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas
26 Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary
28 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said
29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
30 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
31 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
32 successor.

33 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
 34 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 35 AUTHORITY - DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES PLANNING COUNCIL. The Governor may at
 36 any time transfer all personnel, appropriations, fund balances and authorized

1 positions; and the powers, duties, and personnel of the Developmental
2 Disabilities Planning Council to any other designated agency of the state
3 which meets the requirements of Public Law 104-183. The provisions of this
4 section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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6 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
7 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
8 Any unexpended balance of funds generated by fees and fines pursuant to
9 Arkansas Code 20-8-103 et. seq. deposited into the State General Services Fund
10 Account which remain at the close of each state fiscal year shall be carried
11 forward to the next state fiscal year to be used for the same intent and
12 purposes as set forth in law. The provisions of this section shall be in
13 effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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15 SECTION 9. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
16 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
17 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
18 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
19 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
20 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
21 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
22 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
23 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
24 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
25 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
26 include the following:
27 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
28 expenditures on the fund balance.
29 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
30 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
31 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
32 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
33 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
34 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
35 depletion of the fund balance.
36 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and

1 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
2 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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4 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
7 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
8 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
9 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
10 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
12 with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
21 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
27 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
28 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
29 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
30 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
31 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
32 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
33 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
