9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
10 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE AEGON BUILDING FOR THE
11 ARKANSAS STATE BUILDING SERVICES WHICH SHALL BE
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS
13 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 268 OF 1999; AND FOR OTHER

17 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE BUILDING
18 SERVICES SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
25 State Building Services, to be payable from the Arkansas State Building
26 Services Maintenance Fund, for personal services and operating expenses for
27 the Aegon Building of the Arkansas State Building Services - Building
28 Maintenance which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
29 appropriated in Section 5 of Act 268 of 1999, the following:

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8 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
9 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
10 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
11 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
12 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
13 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
14 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
15 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
16 with in disbursement of said funds.

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18 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
25 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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27 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
28 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
29 the Arkansas State Building Services are, due to unforeseen circumstances,
30 insufficient for the Arkansas State Building Services to continue to provide
31 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide
32 the necessary monies for the Arkansas State Building Services to continue such
33 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
34 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
35 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and
36 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace,

1 health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of
2 its passage and approval.

3 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
4 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
5 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
6 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the
7 veto.
