9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES
10 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION ON
11 LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND TRAINING FOR THE
12 BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2003; AND FOR OTHER
13 PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS COMMISSION
16 ON LAW ENFORCEMENT STANDARDS AND
17 TRAINING APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2001-2003
18 BIENNIAL PERIOD.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas
26 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training for the 2001-2003
27 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries
28 shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and
29 Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all
30 laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a
31 specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt
32 from the provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All
33 persons occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the
34 provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas
35 Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

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32 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,

33 to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training, to be

34 payable from the State General Services Fund Account, for personal services

 21 Training - Special Training for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the

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34 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - DRUG DETECTION TRAINING-FEDERAL. There is hereby
 35 appropriated, to the Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and
 36 Training, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief

1 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Arkansas Commission
2 on Law Enforcement Standards and Training - Drug Detection for the biennial
3 period ending June 30, 2003, the following:

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15 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
16 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY FORWARD.
17 Any unexpended balances of appropriation and funds authorized for Capital
18 Outlay in Section 2 of this Act on June 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, shall be carried
19 forward and made available for the same purpose during the fiscal year ending
20 June 30, ~~2001~~ 2003.

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22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
23 through June 30, 2003.

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25 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
26 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORMS.
27 After seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
28 Committee and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the
29 Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training shall be exempt from
30 Arkansas Code 19-6-109(c) for the purpose of buying uniforms for students.
31 The amount spent for the purchase of uniforms in any one year shall be limited
32 to \$40,000.

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34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
35 through June 30, 2003.

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1 SECTION 7. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 2 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
 3 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
 4 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
 5 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
 6 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
 7 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
 8 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head
 9 shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
 10 requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide
 11 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the
 12 following:
 13 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
 14 expenditures on the fund balance.
 15 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
 16 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
 17 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
 18 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
 19 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
 20 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
 21 depletion of the fund balance.
 22 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
 23 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
 24 prior review by the Legislative Council.

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 26 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
 27 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
 28 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
 29 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
 30 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
 31 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
 32 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
 33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
 34 with in disbursement of said funds.

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 36 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
7 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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9 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
13 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
14 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
15 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
16 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
17 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
18 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
19 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
