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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - NATIONAL GOVERNOR'S ASSOCIATION DUES. There is
28 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
29 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State General Services Fund
30 Account, for payment of the state's contribution to the National Governor's
31 Association by the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
32 Officer which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
33 appropriated in Section 8 of Act 1396 of 1999, the following:

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4 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF STATE LEGISLATURES. There
5 is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
6 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the State General Services Fund
7 Account, for payment of the state's contributions to the National Conference
8 of State Legislatures by the Department of Finance and Administration -
9 Disbursing Officer which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
10 appropriated in Section 8 of Act 1396 of 1999, the following:

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18 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
19 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
20 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
21 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
22 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
23 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
24 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
25 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
26 with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
35 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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1 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
3 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to
4 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and
5 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential
6 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the
7 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing
8 Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of
9 this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and
10 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is
11 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and
13 effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is
14 neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the
15 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill.
16 If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall
17 become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
