 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 10 TRANSFER - EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANEMIA. The Executive Director of the Livestock
 11 and Poultry Commission, with prior review of the Arkansas Legislative Council
 12 and with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, may transfer
 13 funds from the Livestock and Poultry Equine Infectious Anemia Control Fund to
 14 the Livestock and Poultry Fund Account.

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16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 17 through June 30, 2003.

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19 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUFFALO
 21 GNAT CONTROL PROGRAM. The Appropriation authorized for the Buffalo Gnat
 22 Control Program in Item (05) of Section 3 of this Act, shall be expended only
 23 for the control of buffalo gnats in the Arkansas counties of Miller,
 24 LaFayette, Little River and parts of Hempstead.

25

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 27 through June 30, 2003.

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29 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXPENSE
 31 REIMBURSEMENT. Funds appropriated in Item (05), (06) and (07) of Section ~~47~~
 32 19 of this act shall be used to reimburse members of high school 4H clubs,
 33 high school FFA clubs and Miss Arkansas Rodeo for expenses incurred while
 34 representing the State of Arkansas at national conferences and events outside
 35 the State. The State 4H Association and the State FFA Association shall
 36 receive funds appropriated for expense reimbursement of student members but

1 shall be limited to \$20,000 each, or so much thereof that is available.
 2 Reimbursement of expenses for Miss Arkansas Rodeo shall be limited to \$350 per
 3 year.

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 5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

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 8 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SHOW
 10 PREMIUMS. The Executive Director shall promulgate such rules and regulations
 11 as may be necessary for the administration and distribution of the
 12 appropriations authorized by Section ~~47~~ 19 herein.

 14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 15 through June 30, 2003.

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 17 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 19 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation provided in Section 6 of
 20 this Act, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2000~~
 21 2002, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the
 22 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2001~~ 2003.

 24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001

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 27 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 29 TRANSFERS. The Executive Director of the Livestock and Poultry Commission,
 30 with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and prior review by
 31 the Arkansas Legislative Council may transfer funds from the Livestock and
 32 Poultry Commission Disease and Pest Control Fund, Livestock and Poultry Special
 33 Revenue Fund and Swine Testing Fund to the Livestock and Poultry Fund Account.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 35 through June 30, 2003.

1 SECTION 28. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
2 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
3 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
4 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
5 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
6 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
7 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
8 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head
9 shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
10 requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide
11 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the
12 following:
13 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
14 expenditures on the fund balance.
15 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
16 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
17 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
18 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
19 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
20 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
21 depletion of the fund balance.
22 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
23 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
24 prior review by the Legislative Council.

25
26 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
29 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
30 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
31 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of
32 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
33 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
34 with in disbursement of said funds.

35
36 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
7 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
13 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
14 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
15 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
16 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
17 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
18 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
19 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
