## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL  
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE  
11 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION - ARKANSAS STATE LIBRARY  
12 FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2005; AND  
13 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION  
17 - ARKANSAS STATE LIBRARY APPROPRIATION  
18 FOR THE 2003-2005 BIENNIUM.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Education - Arkansas State Library for the 2003-2005 biennium,  
26 the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be  
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act  
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory  
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum  
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the  
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons  
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions  
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-  
34 101), or its successor.

30 Department of Education - Arkansas State Library - State for the 2003-2005  
31 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees,  
32 to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such  
33 purposes: seven (7) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates  
34 of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and  
35 Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate  
36 classification.

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2 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
3 Department of Education - Arkansas State Library, to be payable from the  
4 State Library Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of  
5 the Department of Education - Arkansas State Library for the biennial period  
6 ending June 30, 2005, the following:

 8 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated  
 9 herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when  
 10 needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform  
 11 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the  
 12 appropriate classification.

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14 SECTION 6. APPROPRIATION - AID TO PUBLIC LIBRARIES. There is hereby  
 15 appropriated, to the Department of Education - Arkansas State Library, to be  
 16 payable from the *State Library Public School Fund Account*, for Aid to Public  
 17 Libraries of the Department of Education - Arkansas State Library for the

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19 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY  
 21 FORWARD. At the close of the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2002~~ June 30, 2004,  
 22 any unexpended balance of appropriation and monies provided from the State  
 23 Library Fund Account for Books and Subscriptions, as provided in Section 3 of  
 24 this Act, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same  
 25 purpose for the fiscal year ending ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

26 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from ~~July 1, 2001~~  
 27 July 1, 2003 through ~~June 30, 2003~~ June 30, 2005.

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29 SECTION 10. ARKANSAS CODE 19-5-305(a) is amended to read as follows:

30 19-5-305. Public School Fund.

32 (a) The Public School Fund shall consist of the following fund accounts and  
 33 funds made available for the support of the Department of Education, ~~and the~~  
 34 Department of Workforce Education, and the Department of Education - Arkansas  
 35 State Library, and shall be used for the same purposes as set out for the  
 36 following fund accounts:

1 (1) Department of Education Public School Fund Account. The Department of  
 2 Education Public School Fund Account shall be used for grants and aids for  
 3 the programs administered by the Department of Education consisting of, but  
 4 not limited to:

- 5 (A) Teacher retirement matching;
- 6 (B) Handicapped children;
- 7 (C) Aid to the county general;
- 8 (D) Guidance services;
- 9 (E) Transportation aid;
- 10 (F) State equalization aid;
- 11 (G) State apportionment;
- 12 (H) Orphans aid;
- 13 (I) Child guidance center;
- 14 (J) Surplus commodities distribution;
- 15 (K) Crippled children;
- 16 (L) Early childhood education;
- 17 (M) School food services;
- 18 (N) Economic education;
- 19 (O) Textbook grants; and

20 ~~(P) Library aid to counties; and~~

21 ~~(Q)~~ (P) Such other grant and aids as may be authorized by law for  
 22 disbursement by the Department of Education; and

23 (2) Department of Workforce Education Public School Fund Account. The  
 24 Department of Workforce Education Public School Fund Account shall be used  
 25 for grants and aids for the programs administered by the Department of  
 26 Workforce Education consisting of, but not limited to:

- 27 (A) General adult education grants;
- 28 (B) Adult basic education grants;
- 29 (C) Manpower development and training grants;
- 30 (D) Vocational-technical and adult education; and
- 31 (E) Such other grants and aids as may be authorized by law for disbursement  
 32 by the Department of Workforce Education; and

33 (3) State Library Public School Fund Account. The State Library Public  
 34 School Fund Account shall be used for Aid to Public Libraries as administered  
 35 by the Department of Education - Arkansas State Library.

36 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

1 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
2 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
3 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and  
4 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
5 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
6 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
7 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
8 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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10 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
11 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
12 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
13 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
14 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
16 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
17 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

18  
19 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
20 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
21 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
22 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of  
23 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
24 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
25 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the  
26 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
27 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
28 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
29 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003.
