17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-201 is amended to read as follows:
20 6-17-201. Requirement.

21 (a) Each school district in the state shall have a set of written
22 personnel policies, including the teacher salary schedule.

23 (b) "Personnel policies" means all school district policies,
24 guidelines, regulations, and procedures that pertain to the terms and
25 conditions of teacher's employment.

26 (c) The personnel policies shall include, but are not limited to, the
27 following terms and conditions of employment:

- 28 (1) Benefits;
- 29 (2) Compensation;
- 30 (3) Designation of work days;
- 31 (4) Holidays and non-instructional days;
- 32 (5) The annual calendar;
- 33 (6) Methods of evaluations;
- 34 (7) Extra duties;
- 35 (8) Leave;
- 36 (9) Grievances;



- 1 (10) Dismissal or non-renewal;
- 2 (11) Reduction in force; and
- 3 (12) Assignment of teacher aides.

4 ~~(b)(1)~~(d)(1) No school district shall receive in any year any funds
5 from the Public School Fund until such district has filed by the established
6 deadline its current personnel policies including any salary schedules, as
7 required by this subchapter, signed by the president of the board.

8 (2) The policy and schedules shall be filed with the Department
9 of Education no later than September 15 of each year.

10 ~~(e)~~(e) The department shall notify any district that has not filed
11 such policies in accordance with this section.
