24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-43-313 is amended to read as follows:
25 § 14-43-313. City clerks and attorneys generally.

26 ~~(a) At the general election in cities of the first class held in 1894~~
27 ~~and every two (2) years thereafter, there shall be elected by the qualified~~
28 ~~electors of these cities a city clerk and city attorney who shall hold office~~
29 ~~for the two (2) years next following and until their successors are elected~~
30 ~~and qualified.~~

31 ~~(b) The city clerk and city attorney in cities of the first class shall~~
32 ~~give the bond, perform the duties, and receive the salary as is prescribed by~~
