12 AN ACT PERTAINING TO LOAN FORGIVENESS
13 PROGRAMS FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
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17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-50-204 is amended to read as follows:
20 6-50-204. Institutional eligibility.

21 *The institution to be attended under the loan forgiveness program must*
22 *be approved by the State Board of Workforce Education and Career*
23 *Opportunities or the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board or the*
24 *State Board of Private Career Education to offer training in the technical*
25 *field chosen by the applicant.*
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27 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-50-206 is amended to read as follows:
28 6-50-206. Student eligibility - Initial certification of eligibility.

29 (a) *The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities*
30 *shall certify eligibility for persons who meet the following conditions:*

31 (1) *Are ~~residents of the State of Arkansas and~~ citizens of the*
32 *United States or permanent resident aliens;*

33 (2) *Are admitted to an approved program resulting in a diploma,*
34 *certificate, or degree in a high-demand technical field;*

35 (3) *Have a grade point average as required in the rules and*
36 *regulations for administration of this loan forgiveness program for the*



1 *specified technical field; and*

2 *(4) Indicate an intention to work in Arkansas in the high-demand*
3 *technical field for which they receive the training.*

4 *(b) Students must apply for the loan forgiveness program and be*
5 *selected by a process administered by the board.*

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7 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
8 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a continuing and
9 pressing need for skilled technical workers by business and industry in
10 Arkansas which makes it necessary to establish this Arkansas Technical
11 Careers Student Loan Forgiveness Program to aid persons desiring to enter an
12 educational program. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
13 act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
14 health, and safety shall become effective on:

15 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

16 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
17 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
18 bill; or

19 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
20 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
