18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-5-504 is amended to read as follows:

21 8-5-504. Chlorides standard.

22 Should the water of any stream of this state have more than two hundred
23 *fifty (250) parts per million of chlorides as a result of a violation of this*
24 *subchapter*, then the Arkansas Pollution Control and Ecology Commission shall
25 seek to learn of the source of the pollution and take steps to eliminate the
26 source of pollution.
