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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 21, Chapter 12, Subchapter 5 is amended
25 to add an additional section to read as follows:

26 21-12-504. State agencies required to report impending layoffs of
27 state employees.

28 (a) Any state agency, board, or commission that announces a layoff of
29 state employees shall file a report as soon as possible with the Legislative
30 Council and the Office of Personnel Management of the Division of the
31 Division of Management Services of the Department of Finance and
32 Administration.

33 (b) The report shall include the job titles and programs involved in
34 the impending layoff.

35 (c) It is the responsibility of the Office of Personnel Management and
36 Bureau of Legislative Research to insure that the eliminated positions are



1 removed from the agency, institutions, board, or commission budget for the
2 next biennium.

3 (d) This section does not apply to institutions of higher education.
