31	another biennium; and that unless this emergency clause is adopted there will				
32	be a gap in its work effort and its momentum might be lost. Therefore, an				
33	emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the				
34	preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective on				
35	July 1, 2003.
