22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-103-106 is amended to read as follows:*  
25 *17-103-106. Penalties and enforcement.*

26 *(a) Violations of this chapter shall constitute Class A misdemeanors.*

27 *(b)(1)(A) When the Social Work Licensing Board is made aware of a*  
28 *possible violation of § 17-103-105, a registered letter with a return receipt*  
29 *requested shall be mailed to the individual in question, calling to his or*  
30 *her attention the pertinent aspects of the law and the rules and regulations*  
31 *of the board.*

32 *(B) If the individual continues the alleged illegal*  
33 *practice, the information shall be forwarded to the appropriate law*  
34 *enforcement authorities for legal action.*

35 *(2) The Arkansas Social Work Licensing Board shall assist the*  
36 *prosecuting attorney in the enforcement of this chapter, ~~and.~~*
