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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-2-102(a), concerning commission fees and
22 duplicate oaths to be forwarded to Secretary of State, is amended to read as
23 follows:

24 (a)(1) All state and county officers, both civil and military, except
25 judges elected at the nonpartisan judicial general election without a runoff,
26 who are required by law to be commissioned by the Governor, are required to
27 forward the legal fee for their commissions to the Secretary of State within
28 sixty (60) days after their election.

29 (2) All judges elected at the nonpartisan judicial general
30 election without a runoff are required to forward the legal fee for their
31 commissions to the Secretary of State within sixty (60) days after the
32 November general election.

33 ~~(2)(3)~~ They shall, within fifteen (15) days after the
34 commissions have been received, forward their duplicate oath to the Secretary
35 of State to be recorded and filed in his office.
