20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-18-203(a) is amended to read as follows:

23 (a)(1) ~~When~~ Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection,
24 when any person owns a tract of land on which the person resides and which
25 tract of land is located partially in one (1) school district and partially
26 in another, the school-age children of that person shall attend school in the
27 school district in which the residence is located.

28 (2) When a person owned an undivided tract of land on which that
29 person domiciled for ten (10) or more years prior to August 13, 2001, and
30 which undivided tract of land is located partially in one school district and
31 partially in another, the school-age children of that person, and those of
32 his or her successors in title, shall be eligible to attend the school in
33 either of the districts, regardless of the location of the home on the
34 property.
