FINGERPRINTS OF APPLICANTS FOR A NURSING LICENSE  
BE DESTROYED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO DELETE THE REQUIREMENT THAT  
FINGERPRINTS OF APPLICANTS FOR A NURSING  
LICENSE BE DESTROYED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-87-312(e) is repealed.

~~(e) At the conclusion of any background check required by this section, the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State Police shall promptly destroy the fingerprint card of the applicant.~~
