20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-17-108 is amended to read as follows:

23 16-17-108. Salaries of personnel and other requirements of various
24 ~~municipal~~ district courts.

25 (a) The Alexander ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive a
26 monthly salary of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250).

27 (b) The Arkadelphia-Clark County ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall
28 receive an annual salary of not less than fifty-three thousand five hundred
29 dollars (\$53,500) nor more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), and the
30 Arkadelphia-Clark County ~~Municipal~~ District Court Clerk shall receive an
31 annual salary of not less than twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000) nor
32 more than twenty-nine thousand one hundred twenty dollars (\$29,120), such
33 salaries to be established annually by the Clark County Quorum Court. Upon
34 approval by the Clark County Quorum Court, the Arkadelphia-Clark County
35 ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge may appoint one (1) deputy ~~municipal~~ district
36 clerk to receive a salary as established by the Clark County Quorum Court.



1 (c) The Ashdown ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
2 salary of not less than ~~twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$28,000)~~ thirty-two
3 thousand eight hundred (\$32,800) nor more than forty-four thousand dollars
4 (\$44,000), as determined by the governing body of the City of Ashdown and the
5 Quorum Court of Little River County. The salary shall be paid sixty-two
6 percent (62%) by Little River County and thirty-eight percent (38%) by the
7 City of Ashdown, unless otherwise agreed by the Quorum Court of Little River
8 County and the governing body of the City of Ashdown.

9 (d) The Ash Flat ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
10 annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor
11 more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and the Ash Flat ~~Municipal~~
12 District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen
13 thousand dollars (\$14,000) nor more than seventeen thousand dollars
14 (\$17,000), as determined by the Quorum Court of Sharp County and to be paid
15 by Sharp County.

16 (e) The Augusta ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
17 salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800) nor more
18 than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000), the city and the county to share
19 the cost equally.

20 (f) The Batesville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
21 annual salary of not less than ~~twenty-six thousand four hundred dollars~~
22 ~~(\$26,400)~~ thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than ~~thirty-eight~~
23 ~~thousand seven hundred twenty (\$38,720)~~ forty-three thousand dollars
24 (\$43,000), as determined by the governing body of Batesville and the Quorum
25 Court of Independence County.

26 (g) The Beebe ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
27 salary of not less than ~~eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000)~~ twenty-four
28 thousand nine hundred eighty dollars (\$24,980) nor more than ~~twenty-seven~~
29 ~~thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500)~~ thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).
30 The ~~municipal~~ district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less
31 than ~~seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000)~~ twenty-four thousand four hundred
32 dollars (\$24,400) nor more than ~~twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000)~~ thirty
33 thousand dollars (\$30,000).

34 (h) The Benton ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
35 salary of not less than ~~sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)~~ fifty thousand
36 dollars (\$50,000) nor more than ~~ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000)~~ ninety-nine

1 thousand dollars (\$99,000), and the court clerk shall receive an annual
2 salary of not less thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than forty
3 thousand dollars (\$40,000). Such salaries shall be as determined by the
4 governing body of the City of Benton and the Saline County Quorum Court.

5 (i) The Benton County ~~Municipal~~ District Court-West Judge shall
6 receive an annual salary of not less than seventeen thousand dollars
7 (\$17,000) and not more than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), as
8 determined by the Benton County Quorum Court and the governing bodies of the
9 City of Gentry and the City of Decatur. One-half (1/2) of the salary is to be
10 paid by Benton County, one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the
11 City of Decatur, and one-fourth (1/4) of the salary is to be paid by the City
12 of Gentry.

13 (j) The Bentonville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
14 annual salary of not less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) nor
15 more than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), as determined by the City Council
16 of Bentonville in concurrence with the Benton County Quorum Court.

17 (k) The Berryville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
18 annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) and not
19 more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).

20 (l) The Biscoe ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
21 salary of not less than three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600) nor more
22 than thirteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$13,600).

23 (m) The Blytheville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
24 annual salary of not less than ~~forty thousand dollars (\$40,000)~~ forty-five
25 thousand dollars (\$45,000) nor more than ~~fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000)~~,
26 seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) as may be approved by the Mississippi
27 County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Blytheville.

28 (n) The Booneville ~~Municipal~~ District Judge shall receive an annual
29 salary of not less than twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) nor more than
30 forty thousand dollars (\$40,000), as may be determined by the City Council of
31 the City of Booneville and the Quorum Court of Logan County and shall be
32 payable one-half (1/2) by the City of Booneville and one-half (1/2) by Logan
33 County and shall be paid in twelve (12) equal monthly installments.

34 (o) The Bradley County ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
35 annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more
36 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) as established by the Bradley

1 County Quorum Court and approved by the governing body of the City of Warren.

2 (p) The Brinkley ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
3 annual salary of not less than ten thousand two hundred dollars (\$10,200) nor
4 more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), and the Brinkley ~~Municipal~~
5 District Court Clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten
6 thousand four hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$10,488) and not more than twenty
7 thousand dollars (\$20,000).

8 (q) The Bryant ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
9 salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than
10 ~~thirty nine thousand five hundred dollars (\$39,500)~~ fifty thousand dollars
11 (\$50,000).

12 (r) The Cabot ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
13 salary of not less than twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) nor more than
14 ~~twenty six thousand dollars (\$26,000)~~ thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), as
15 may be determined by the governing body of the City of Cabot.

16 (s) The Camden ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
17 salary of not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) nor more than fifty
18 thousand dollars (\$50,000), to be paid by the City of Camden and Ouachita
19 County.

20 (t) The Carlisle ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
21 annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500)
22 nor more than nineteen thousand dollars (\$19,000).

23 (u) The Charleston ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
24 annual salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than
25 ~~sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000)~~ eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000). The
26 salaries and costs may be set and the payment thereof may be apportioned by
27 agreement between the governing body of the City of Charleston and the
28 Franklin County Quorum Court.

29 (v) The Clarendon ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
30 annual salary of not less than four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$4,800),
31 and the Clarendon ~~Municipal~~ District Court Clerk shall receive an annual
32 salary of not less than eight thousand nine hundred eighty-eight dollars
33 (\$8,988).

34 (w) The Clarksville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
35 annual salary of not less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) nor
36 more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000). This expense, as well as all

1 other expenses related to the operation of the Clarksville ~~Municipal~~ District
2 Court, is to be divided among the county and all cities within the county
3 based on the percentage of the total fine money collected during the year by
4 each participating entity.

5 (x) The Clinton-Van Buren County ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall
6 receive an annual salary of not less than eleven thousand dollars (\$11,000)
7 nor more than thirty-three thousand dollars (\$33,000), as determined by the
8 City Council of Clinton and the Quorum Court of Van Buren County. This salary
9 and that of the clerk and any deputies shall be apportioned between the
10 county and any city therein by agreement between the respective governing
11 bodies.

12 (y) The Conway ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
13 salary of not less than sixty-five thousand dollars (\$65,000) nor more than
14 one hundred ten thousand dollars (\$110,000).

15 (z)(1)(A) The Judge of the ~~Municipal~~ District Courts of Corning,
16 Piggott, and Rector shall receive an annual salary of not less than seventeen
17 thousand dollars (\$17,000) nor more than thirty-six thousand dollars
18 (\$36,000), to be paid, as well as other current benefits, in equal monthly
19 installments by Clay County.

20 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
21 by the City of Corning, the City of Piggott, and the City of Rector at
22 eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%), eighteen and one-half percent (18.5%),
23 and thirteen percent (13%), respectively, to the county treasury.

24 (2)(A) The clerks of the respective ~~municipal~~ district courts
25 shall receive an annual salary of not less than four thousand five hundred
26 dollars (\$4,500) nor more than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000), to be paid,
27 as well as other current benefits, in equal monthly installments by Clay
28 County.

29 (B) Fifty percent (50%) of the amount shall be reimbursed
30 by the respective cities.

31 (aa)(1) The Judge of the ~~Municipal~~ District Court of Craighead County
32 shall be a full-time ~~municipal~~ district judge and shall receive as
33 compensation for services an annual salary of not less than seventy-nine
34 thousand nine hundred dollars (\$79,900) nor more than eighty-seven thousand
35 dollars (\$87,000), as determined by the Quorum Court of Craighead County and
36 the governing body of the City of Jonesboro, to be paid in equal monthly

1 installments. The amount of the salary shall be appropriated by ordinance
2 adopted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County. The amount of the salary and
3 necessary expenses appropriated for the court shall be apportioned among and
4 paid to the county from the respective cities of the first class and cities
5 of the second class, incorporated towns, and the government of Craighead
6 County as a prorated amount based on the number of cases filed from each of
7 the towns and cities and the county during the preceding calendar year.
8 Apportionment of the costs of the court shall be by order of the ~~Municipal~~
9 District court upon certification of the cases filed by the Clerk of the
10 ~~Municipal District~~ Court of Craighead County.

11 (2) The Judge of the ~~Municipal District~~ Court of Craighead
12 County shall maintain dockets and hold court, as deemed necessary, in each of
13 the county seats of Craighead County and may establish dockets and hold court
14 in other cities and towns in Craighead County as deemed necessary by
15 ordinance adopted by the Quorum Court of Craighead County.

16 (bb) The Crossett ~~Municipal District~~ Court Judge shall receive an
17 annual salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800)
18 nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the ~~municipal~~
19 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven
20 thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than nineteen thousand five hundred
21 dollars (\$19,500). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
22 prescribed in this subsection, as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum
23 Court and the governing body of the City of Crossett.

24 (cc) *The DeQueen ~~Municipal District~~ Court Judge shall receive an*
25 *annual salary of not less than ~~twenty-one thousand dollars (\$21,000) nor more~~*
26 *~~than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) fifty percent (50%), nor more~~*
27 *than eighty percent (80%) of the annual salary established by law for circuit*
28 *judges. The DeQueen ~~Municipal District~~ Court Clerk shall have an annual*
29 *salary of not less than fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000). The salaries,*
30 *expenses, and operating costs of the ~~Municipal District~~ Court of the City of*
31 *DeQueen shall be paid equally by the City of DeQueen and the County of*
32 *Sevier.*

33 (dd)(1)(A) The Dermott ~~Municipal District~~ Court Judge shall receive an
34 annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more
35 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).

36 (B)(i) The court clerk shall receive an annual salary of

1 not less than twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) nor more than eighteen
2 thousand dollars (\$18,000).

3 (ii) Provided, however, that the court clerk's
4 position shall be a full-time or part-time position.

5 (2) The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
6 prescribed in this subsection as agreed upon by the Chicot County Quorum
7 Court and the governing body of the City of Dermott.

8 (ee) The Des Arc ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
9 annual salary of not less than seven thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than
10 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000).

11 (ff) The DeValls Bluff ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
12 annual salary of not less than three thousand six hundred dollars (\$3,600)
13 nor more than thirteen thousand six hundred dollars (\$13,600). The DeWitt
14 ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual salary of not less
15 than thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000), nor more than twenty-three thousand
16 dollars (\$23,000), the ~~municipal~~ district court clerk shall receive an annual
17 salary of not less than twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500) nor
18 more than twenty-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$22,500), and the deputy
19 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than ten thousand five
20 hundred dollars (\$10,500) nor more than twenty thousand five hundred dollars
21 (\$20,500). The salaries shall be determined by the governing body of the
22 City of DeWitt and the Arkansas County Quorum Court and paid equally by the
23 city and the county.

24 (gg) The Dumas ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
25 salary of not less than twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$27,500)
26 nor more than forty-three thousand dollars (\$43,000). The clerk of the court
27 shall receive an annual salary of not less than eighteen thousand dollars
28 (\$18,000) nor more than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the deputy
29 clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than fourteen thousand five
30 hundred dollars (\$14,500) nor more than twenty-three thousand dollars
31 (\$23,000). The salaries shall be paid one-half (1/2) by the Desha County
32 Quorum Court and one-half (1/2) by the City of Dumas and shall be determined
33 by the Desha County Quorum Court and the governing body of the City of Dumas.

34 (hh) The Elkins ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an annual
35 salary of not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than ~~twenty~~
36 ~~thousand dollars (\$20,000)~~ twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000). The

1 annual salary for each clerk of the Elkins ~~Municipal~~ District Court shall be
2 not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) nor more than thirty-five
3 thousand dollars (\$35,000).

4 (ii) If a ~~municipal~~ district court is established in Eudora, the judge
5 shall receive an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars
6 (\$16,000) nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the clerk
7 shall receive an annual salary of not less than twelve thousand dollars
8 (\$12,000) nor more than eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000).

9 (jj) The Eureka Springs ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive
10 an annual salary of not less than sixteen thousand dollars (\$16,000) nor more
11 than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000).

12 (kk) The Fayetteville ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
13 annual salary of not less than sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) nor more than
14 ~~eighty five thousand dollars (\$85,000)~~ ninety-five thousand dollars
15 (\$95,000). The annual salary of the Judge of the ~~Municipal~~ District Court of
16 Fayetteville may be increased in the amounts as may be agreed by the Quorum
17 Court of Washington County and the governing body of the City of Fayetteville
18 by ordinances or resolutions adopted by their respective bodies.

19 (ll) The Fordyce ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
20 annual salary of not less than ~~twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000)~~ fifteen
21 thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than ~~twenty four thousand dollars~~
22 ~~(\$24,000)~~ thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and each clerk of the court
23 shall receive an annual salary of not less than ~~ten thousand dollars~~
24 ~~(\$10,000)~~ fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than ~~twenty thousand~~
25 ~~dollars (\$20,000)~~ twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000), as may be
26 determined by the Fordyce City Council and the Dallas County Quorum Court,
27 and the salaries shall be paid by the City of Fordyce and Dallas County in
28 equal monthly installments.

29 (mm) The Forrest City ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
30 annual salary of not less than ~~thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000)~~ forty-two
31 thousand five hundred dollars (\$42,500) nor more than fifty-five thousand
32 dollars (\$55,000), as may be set by the Quorum Court of St. Francis County
33 and the governing body of Forrest City.

34 (nn)(1) The Fort Smith ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judges shall receive
35 *annual salaries of not less than* ~~seventy five thousand dollars (\$75,000)~~
36 eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) *nor more than* ~~eighty eight thousand dollars~~

1 ~~(\$88,000)~~ ninety-one thousand dollars (\$91,000), as may be determined by the
2 governing body of the City of Fort Smith. Special judges shall be paid at
3 the rate of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) per day.

4 (2) The ~~municipal~~ district judges shall appoint a qualified
5 elector to serve as ~~municipal~~ district court clerk. The salaries of the
6 ~~municipal~~ district judges, the ~~municipal~~ district court clerks, and any
7 special judges authorized by subdivision (nm)(2) of this section and the
8 operating expenses of the Fort Smith ~~Municipal~~ District Court shall be paid
9 seventy percent (70%) by the City of Fort Smith and thirty percent (30%) by
10 Sebastian County. The ~~municipal~~ district judges shall be of good moral
11 character, residents and electors of the city and the state, and shall
12 possess the qualifications required by law for circuit ~~and chancery~~ judges.
13 In the event a ~~municipal~~ district judge is ill, absent, or temporarily
14 disqualified, that ~~municipal~~ district judge shall designate a member of the
15 bar regularly practicing in the court to serve in his place during the
16 illness, absence, or disqualification of the ~~municipal~~ district judge, and he
17 shall have all the powers and authority of the ~~municipal~~ district judge. The
18 special judge so appointed shall be paid one hundred dollars (\$100) for each
19 day he serves, to be paid by the city and county.

20 (3) Upon a vacancy in the office of ~~municipal~~ district judge
21 caused by death or otherwise, the vacancy shall be filled as prescribed by
22 the Arkansas Constitution.

23 (oo) ~~The Greenwood Municipal District Court Judge shall receive an~~
24 ~~annual salary of not less than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000) nor~~
25 ~~more than eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000)~~ one hundred thousand dollars
26 (\$100,000), to be set by the Quorum Court of Sebastian County, and the
27 salaries of the court clerk and the clerk's deputies shall be set by the
28 Quorum Court of Sebastian County. At least thirty (30) days before the
29 candidate filing deadline for the 2004 election, the Quorum Court of
30 Sebastian County may vote to declare the position of Greenwood District Court
31 Judge to be full-time and prohibit the judge from the private practice of law
32 beginning January 1, 2005. The salaries shall be paid ninety percent (90%) by
33 Sebastian County and ten percent (10%) by the City of Greenwood. In order to
34 defray the expenses of operating the Greenwood ~~Municipal~~ District Court,
35 ninety percent (90%) of the Sebastian County net fines, ten percent (10%) of
36 the City of Greenwood net fines, and fifteen percent (15%) of all other

1 cities' net fines processed by the Greenwood ~~Municipal~~ District Court may or
2 shall be deposited in a bank account entitled the "Greenwood ~~Municipal~~
3 District Court Operating Fund" to be administered by the Greenwood ~~Municipal~~
4 District Court Judge pursuant to a budget approved as follows: the ~~municipal~~
5 district judge shall submit a proposed annual budget to a committee composed
6 of the members of the quorum court that represent the Greenwood District of
7 Sebastian County. The committee shall approve the judge's budget or
8 formulate a reasonable budget which shall be approved by the Quorum Court of
9 Sebastian County, unless found by a majority of the quorum court to be
10 clearly excessive. If funds provided from the fines as set out in this
11 subsection become insufficient or excessive, the committee shall adjust the
12 percentage of fines on a pro rata basis to increase or decrease the funds
13 necessary to operate the court pursuant to the budget established in this
14 subsection. The Judge of the Greenwood ~~Municipal~~ District Court shall be
15 bonded in accordance with §§ 19-1-401 - 19-1-403.

16 (pp) The Hamburg ~~Municipal~~ District Court Judge shall receive an
17 annual salary of not less than ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800)
18 nor more than twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), and the ~~municipal~~
19 district court clerk shall receive an annual salary of not less than seven
20 thousand dollars (\$7,000) nor more than nineteen thousand five hundred
21 dollars (\$19,500). The salaries shall be in an amount within the range
22 prescribed in this subsection, as agreed upon by the Ashley County Quorum
23 Court and the governing body of the City of Hamburg.

24 (qq)(1) The Judge of the Hampton ~~Municipal~~ District Court shall
25 receive an annual salary of not less than ~~six thousand dollars (\$6,000)~~
26 fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) nor more than ~~eighteen thousand dollars~~
27 ~~(\$18,000)~~ thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000), and the clerk of the court shall
28 receive an annual salary of not less than ~~six thousand dollars (\$6,000)~~
29 twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000), nor more than ~~nineteen thousand dollars~~
30 ~~(\$19,000)~~ twenty-four thousand dollars (\$24,000), as may be determined by the
31 Hampton City Council and the Calhoun County Quorum Court.
