## Subtitle

13 AN ACT TO AMEND THE PAYROLL DEDUCTION  
14 SECTION OF THE GENERAL ACCOUNTING AND  
15 BUDGETARY PROCEDURES LAW.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-4-1602 is amended to read as follows:  
22 19-4-1602. Payroll deductions.

23 (a) Deductions from the payrolls of state employees, both regular and  
24 extra help, ~~shall be permitted~~ are authorized only for the following  
25 purposes:

26 (1) Withholding taxes;  
27 (2) Social security contributions;  
28 (3) Contributions to any state retirement system or approved  
29 plan of deferred compensation;

30 (4) Group hospital, medical, and life insurance deductions.  
31 However, any payroll deductions through the Arkansas state mechanized payroll  
32 system for state employees for coverages other than the state-authorized plan  
33 shall be approved by the State and Public School Life Insurance Board;

34 (5) Payments to state employees' credit unions;  
35 (6) Value of maintenance perquisites;  
36 (7) Payment of union dues, when requested in writing by state

2 (8) Purchase of United States Government savings bonds;

3 (9) Arkansas State Employees' Association, Inc., dues, when  
4 requested in writing by those state employees;

5 (10) Fees for participation in the State Employees Benefit  
6 Corporation, when requested in writing by those state employees;

7 (11) Contributions to the major federated fund-raising  
8 organization, when authorized by those state employees;

9 (12) Arkansas State Police Association dues, when authorized in  
10 writing by those state employees;

11 (13) Fraternal Order of Police dues, when requested in writing  
12 by those state employees;

13 (14) Central Arkansas State Troopers Coalition dues, when  
14 authorized in writing by those state employees;

15 (15) Arkansas Rehabilitation Association dues, when authorized  
16 in writing by those state employees;

17 (16) Correction Peace Officers Foundation dues, when authorized  
18 in writing by those state employees;

19 (17) Arkansas Department of Correction employee association  
20 dues, when requested in writing by those employees; ~~and~~

21 (18) American Association of University Professors dues, when  
22 requested in writing by those employees; and

23 (19) For such other purposes as are specifically authorized by  
24 law but not enumerated in this subsection.

25 (b) If a state employee authorizes in writing the payroll deduction of  
26 dues of any union or professional association representing the employee, the  
27 agency shall deduct the dues from the payroll of the employee and remit the  
28 dues to the organization.

29 ~~(b)(c)~~ Deductions as are authorized by this section shall be made in  
30 compliance with rules, regulations, and procedures established by the Chief  
31 Fiscal Officer of the State.
