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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 26-27-307, is amended to read as follows:
23 26-27-307. Secretary of board.

24 (a) The clerk of the county court or the clerk's designee shall serve
25 as secretary of the equalization board of ~~his~~ the clerk's county and shall
26 keep a complete and accurate journal of its proceedings and perform such
27 other duties as may be by law required by the board.

28 (b) In addition, within ten (10) days after the appointment of the
29 equalization board for ~~his~~ the clerk's county, the clerk or the clerk's
30 designee shall file from time to time with the Assessment Coordination
31 ~~Division Department of the Arkansas Public Service Commission~~ a statement
32 showing the name and address of each member of the board.

33 (c) When any change in the personnel of the board is made, ~~he~~ the
34 clerk shall immediately so advise the commission.
