## For An Act To Be Entitled

11 AN ACT TO PERMIT DISABLED VETERANS PARKING  
12 PRIVILEGES IN THOSE AREAS DESIGNATED FOR PARKING  
13 ONLY BY PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

16 TO PERMIT DISABLED VETERANS PARKING

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. A vehicle displaying a special "disabled veteran" license  
26 plate issued to a totally and permanently disabled service-connected veteran  
27 under Arkansas Code § 27-15-403, or a valid "disabled veteran" license plate  
28 issued by another state, and being used for the actual transporting of a  
29 disabled veteran, is permitted parking privileges in those areas designated  
30 for parking only by persons with disabilities under the "Access to Parking  
31 for Persons with Disabilities Act", Arkansas Code §§ 27-15-301 et seq.
